Cattle News from Producers:

The seasonal trend for improved cattle prices is holding true as we enter early Spring. Strong demand continues, but calf prices seem to have leveled off after posting big gains since late last Fall and the beginning of the New Year.

Slaughter cow and bull prices have improved significantly in the past 6 to 8 weeks. In recent weeks, we've sold several high yielding and heavy weight bulls from \$86 to \$94 per hundred weight which has them grossing from \$1400 to \$1800 per head. If you have older bulls or bulls with issues that need replacing, now may be the ideal time. Young, high quality breeding bulls are readily available and much more affordable than in years past. Prices from \$1750 to \$3500 per head seems to be where that market stands for now.

Sheep and Goat News:

Here comes Spring and the subsoil moisture is as good as I can remember. With just average rainfall, most of us should have a wonderful early Spring and hopefully it will carry over into Summer. Along with the wonderful rainfall, issues with stomach worms are just around the corner which can counteract performance. Be proactive, not reactive. We have already seen some sick sheep come through the sale ring. The sheep and goat markets are really good in our area, but you must get a healthy animal across the scales for a pay check. I know I wrote about this in January but some things need to be repeated.

The demand for females should be good again this summer if range conditions continue in good shape. The predators are one of the things most mentioned on many of my calls from every direction in our area. We must continue to support Wildlife Services as well as doing what we can on our own.

The numbers moving through auctions around the country have stayed fairly low which has helped us maintain a good market. It is certainly not too early to start marketing those 60 plus pound lambs and kids even though they are doing well on the winter weeds. Sometimes the heavier lambs can actually dollar out less than they would have brought at a lighter weight. The numbers are certainly going to pick up and if we have a really big sale that comes up all of a sudden, it could affect the market negatively. We continue to see an increase in the numbers of hair sheep versus wool sheep in our area, which is no surprise to many and, of course, many producers have both types.

Remember, we will again have our Sheep and Goat Replacement Sale on Saturday, March 23, 2019.
